In the case of The Dead Sea Scrolls they are: The Discovery of the Scrolls; The Essenes; The Site of Qumran; The Scrolls and Christianity; The Scrolls and Judaism; The Scrolls and the Bible; The Battle for the Scrolls; Personalities in the Discovery and Subsequent Controversies.

This series contains the latest scholarship about a specific subject, gives great opportunity for acquiring a limited but significant amount of knowledge, and enthuses readers to go into it in much more detail. This possibility is enhanced by the presence in the Dead Sea Scrolls volume of suggestions for further reading at the end of each chapter.
